



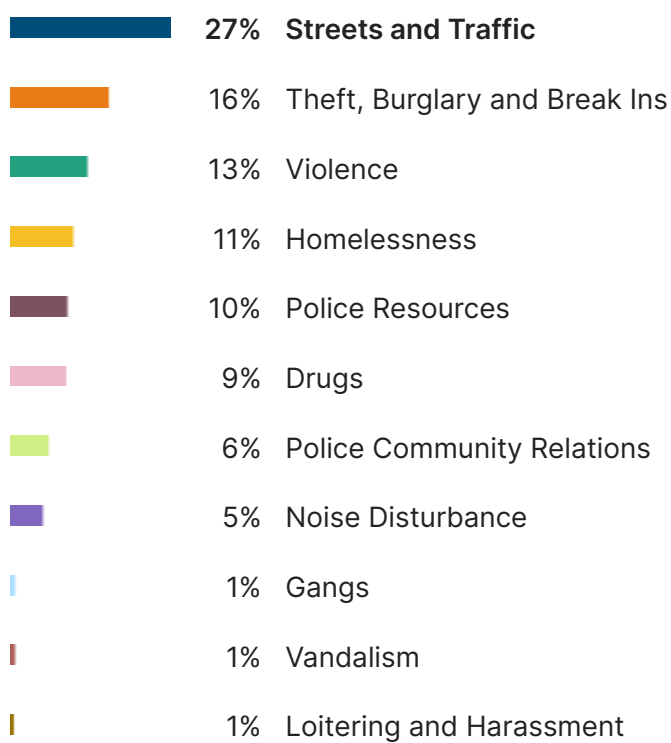
# Blockwise - Executive Summary Report

**Perception of Safety** - 62% of respondents indicated they felt mostly or completely safe in Orange County with 82% stating they would be willing to contact OCSO if they were the victim of a crime or had another concern. This is the first month of data for OCSO and will serve as a foundation to track future trends as more data is accumulated.

The **Top Concern** of respondents was **Streets and Traffic**. This was represented throughout the county as a whole and the primary issue for each area. 80% of respondents had not been the victim of a crime in the past six months. This provides a significant enhancement of data beyond reported crime data.

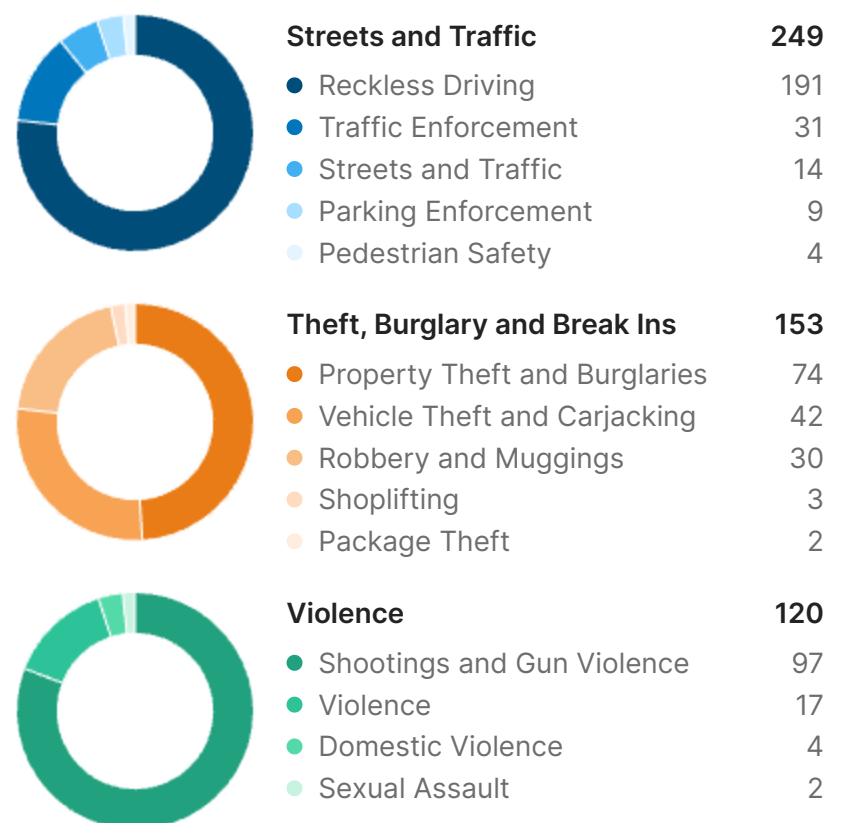

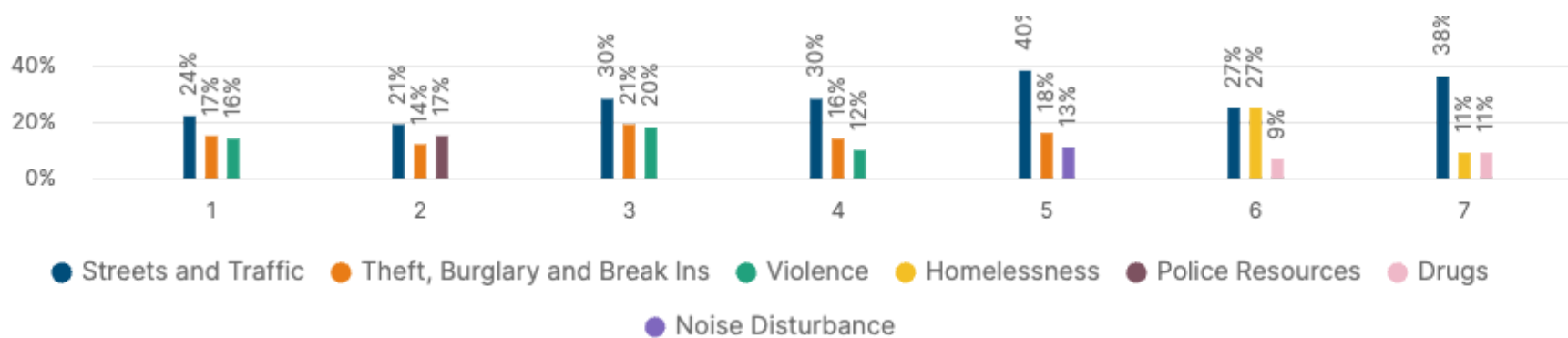


## Top 3 concerns breakdown

## Top concerns by area

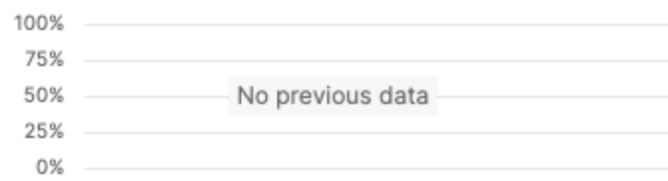


## Scores Over Time and by Area

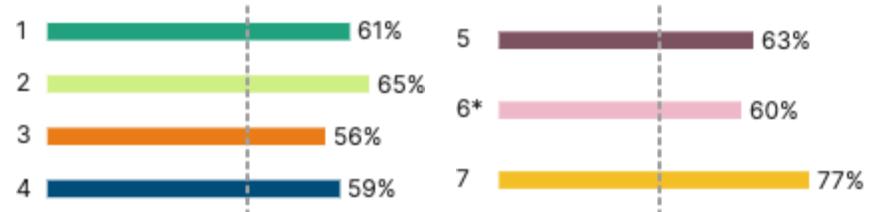

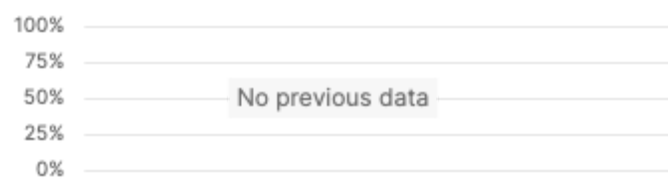

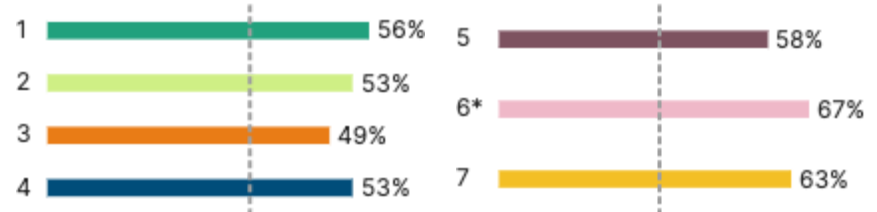
#### Score by Area



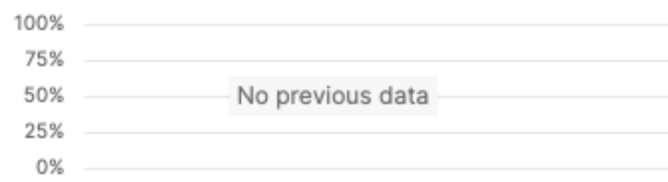
### 54% Fairness



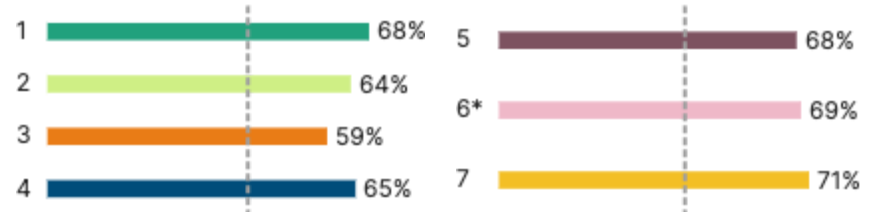
#### Score by Area



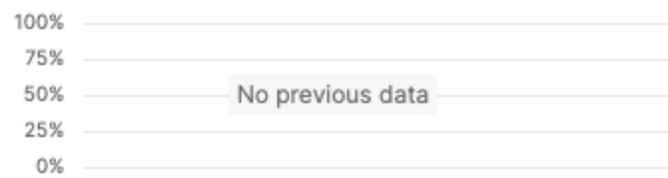
### 65% Respect



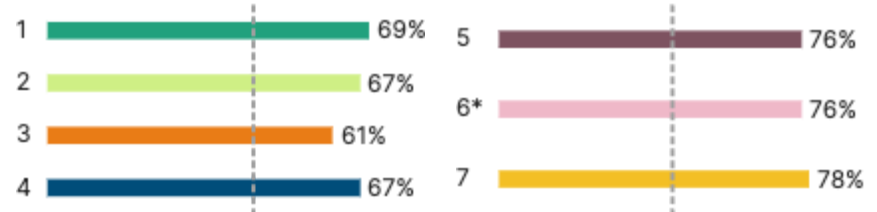
#### Score by Area
